3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. 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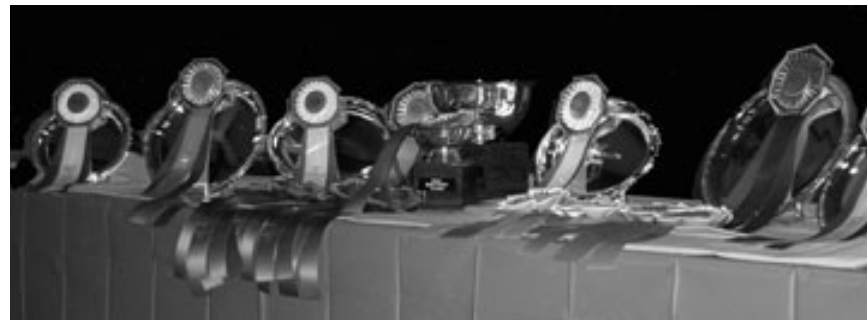

Notice to Exhibitors

Show Hours: 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM Eastern Standard Time (EST), Saturday, March 5, 2005 and Sunday, March 6, 2005.

Express mail or other similar overnight delivery users: *Be sure to sign the signature waiver!* Failure to do so may delay the receipt of your entry. Show Secretary is not available to sign receipts during the day and will not travel to the post office or delivery service location to pick up entries.

The class with the highest entry fee is considered the first entry.

Make all checks and money orders payable to HLRC, Inc. Send checks or money orders with entries. The Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Foreign Exhibitors: Please make fees payable in US funds.

Credit Cards are *not* accepted as payment for entries.

A Recording Fee of 50¢ and an Event Fee of \$1.50 is required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. These fees are collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the fees are collected on the first entry only (Dog Show Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2).

Any Overpayment of Entries will be donated to the Central Indiana Lab Rescue and Adoption, Inc.

Telegraph, Telephone, FAX, e-mail, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted.

Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable.

Entries received without fees will not be accepted.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The Show Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Any class changes or cancellations must be received in writing (e-mail is acceptable) by the Show Secretary prior to closing. Refunds will be made after the show.

Errors on entry blanks: Owners are responsible for errors on completed forms regardless of whoever fills out the form. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

For agent to be notified, please include a stamped #10 envelope addressed to the agent. Otherwise, acknowledgment will only be sent to address on entry.

The show site will be open to exhibitors after 4:00 PM on Friday, March 4, 2005.

Dogs may arrive at any time prior to judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

There is no room for unentered dogs at this show.

No alcoholic beverages are permitted on the Tippecanoe County Fairgrounds.
